## **About The Carlyle Group**

The Carlyle Group (NASDAQ:CG) is a global investment firm with US\$369 billion of assets under management and more than half of the AUM managed by women, across 531 investment vehicles as of September 30, 2022. Carlyle invests across three segments – Global Private Equity, Global Credit, and Global Investment Solutions – in Asia, Europe, Middle East/North Africa, North America, and South America.
